It has been suggested that the population could number 200 or more, mostly within protected areas. Thailand has captive populations of <i>C. porosus</i> numbering in the thousands and international demand for skins is currently being met by long-established registered captive breeding facilities. Thailand reportedly exported 1850 skins annually from captive sources between 2006 and 2010. With populations remaining fragile and fragmented, it would appear that Thai populations of the species still meet the biological criteria for inclusion in Appendix I. REJECT
