Assessed by IUCN in 2000 as Critically Endangered: the species has been very rarely documented in the wild and a capture in 2006 was the first ever confirmed wild capture of the species since 1939. The species is in demand nationally and in China for medicinal use and there is also some demand in the international pet and Asian food trades. The species is very rare and appears to meet the criteria for inclusion in Appendix I. |
