The population is thought to be stable or increasing and faces no known major threats. The species does not appear to be in significant demand for international trade and it is legally protected under the EU Habitats Directive, protected nationally in both its range States. It therefore no longer appears to meet the biological criteria for inclusion in Appendix I. ACCEPT
