# 57 USA	<i>Dudleya stolonifera</i> and <i>Dudleya traskiae</i> (Laguna Beach Live-forever and Santa Barbara Island Live-forever)	Deletion from Appendix II	Succulent plants endemic to the USA, there has been no recorded export of either <i>D. stolonifera</i> or <i>D. traskiae</i> since the species were listed in Appendix I in 1983 or in Appendix II in 2000. Given the National and State laws that protect the species in the USA, their remote relatively inaccessible locations and evidently low international demand, wild-collection of specimens for international trade is considered very unlikely. It is also unlikely that removal from the CITES Appendices will stimulate trade. The species no longer appears to meet the criteria for inclusion in Appendix II. ACCEPT
