Recent trade outside Madagascar appears to be largely in seeds or in propagated plants. Export of plants, some or all of which are presumed wild-collected, has taken place in the past, although there is no indication of ongoing export from the range State. The scale of the reported trade is small compared with the likely population of the species based on observed densities. Based on available information, this species does not appear to meet the criteria for inclusion in Appendix II of CITES. REJECT
