Recent trade outside Madagascar appears to be very largely in seeds. Some export of plants, presumed wild-collected, has taken place in the past, although there is no indication of ongoing export of wild-collected plants The scale of the reported trade is very small compared with the likely population of the species based on observed densities. Based on available information this species does not appear to meet the criteria for inclusion in Appendix II. REJECT
